"How do we deal with corruption; how do we draw on our faith to have courage under fire?"

What is corruption – spiritually, personally, professionally?

When you witness or experience professional corruption, can you see the roots of spiritual corruption or the erosion of values from earlier beginnings?

In scripture (i.e. 1 Timothy 1:12-17), Paul can be known to admit his mistakes in life—openly, honestly, with accountability. Not minimizing his past but owning it. What are the levels of consideration that you believe prevent this from happening professionally, personally, and spiritually?

How has corruption impacted you at any point in your life?

What are some situations where you had to deal with "corruption" in the past, and how do you find yourself reflecting on it still afterwards?

What is an action/step/prayer you can take on after leaving this session that will help to navigate or address a situation you know of or that impacts you where you know "corruption" exists?

What is a prayer that you may have prayed when facing a situation where corruption was present?
